The Road to Right First Time

Hinkley Point C is the largest construction project that the UK has delivered over 30 years and is supporting the target of net zero emissions by 2050. At the end of 2023 we successfully completed the dome lift which has fully enclosed unit 1 reactor building containment allowing installation of the reactor pressure vessel during 2024. HPC is now moving in to the Mechanical, Electrical and HVAC phase of construction in addition to continuing with the civil engineering work. This presentation will give an overview of the construction to date, what is coming up and how we ensure that our welding quality is 'right first time'.

Jackie has worked in heavy engineering for over 25 years as a Materials and Welding Engineer in both manufacturing and the Supply Chain. She has worked on the Hinkley Point C project in Somerset for over 4 years in the Construction Technical Support team as a Welding Superintendent for EDF who are the Principal Contractor.
