This lecture will provide awareness of the properties of, and risks and hazards surrounding industrial compressed gases supplied in cylinders. It presents information from The British Compressed Gas Association (BCGA) Codes of Practice and Guidance Notes. It outlines the sources of information and the user training which is available. It provides guidance on who should be trained and what training should be provided and deals with issues in the use of oxy-fuel systems and the hazard of flashback, cylinders in fires, and selection of equipment.
